



Buckeye Truck Terminals Message

As a preventative measure, the CDC has recommended the use of Facial Coverings to help reduce the spread of the Coronavirus. Several states have also mandated the use of Facial Coverings through Executive Orders by their Governors; such as New York, New Jersey and Pennsylvania. As a result, and effective immediately, Buckeye will require all employees, contractors, truck drivers, customers, and anyone else located at a Buckeye terminal within these states to wear a facial covering.

Facial coverings, preferably made of 100% cotton, shall be worn at the truck rack and in any common areas such as the Driver's Kiosk, BOL Rooms and/or Driver's Rooms.

In any State that has or implements these requirements in the future, Buckeye will also include Facial Coverings as required Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) in addition to Hard Hats, Safety Glasses and Protective Toe Footwear. Drivers will not be able to load/unload without wearing a Facial Covering.

In those states requiring Facial Coverings, not wearing them will result in the application of our Driver Violation Policy, which may lead to Lock Out at all Buckeye Terminal Facilities. In those states not requiring Face Coverings, please consider wearing this preventive PPE to protect yourself and others around you.

Buckeye will continue to monitor State Orders mandating this requirement and immediately implement the requirement to wear Facial Coverings at any Buckeye terminals within that State. Buckeye also asks that all Carriers monitor State Orders in their operating area and be prepared to comply accordingly.

Buckeye continues to hold the health and safety of its employees, its customers, and the communities we serve as a top priority. Your assistance and support is very important in implementing these preventive measures and disrupting the transmission of the Coronavirus. Buckeye will inform Carriers and Truck Drivers when conditions change.
